Palo Verde "Desert Museum"

This semi-evergreen is a three-way hybrid tree, combining the best qualities of the Foothill, Blue, and Mexican Palo Verde. The only thornless Palo Verde, it provides ample shade, and blooms abundant brilliant yellow flowers in the spring. The Palo Verde "Desert Museum" has vigorous growth, sturdy, upright branches, small delicate leaves, and dark green bark. A pedestrian friendly tree, this plant produces very little litter and few seed pods, requires very little pruning or staking and blooms over a long period of time. This tree grows very rapidly to approximately 20 feet tall in 3 to 5 years, after which it will not need any irrigation.
