QUEEN'S WREATH

Size (H x W)	0-40' High by 0-10' wide
Flower color	Rose – pink
Flower season	Early Spring to late summer
Exposure	Full Sun
Water	Little to moderate water

The Queens Wreath, a native of Mexico, loves high summer heat, sun and moderate weather. This fast-growing plant can become very tall, up to 40 feet high, therefore it often requires an arbor or trellis for support. Queen's Wreath normally boasts bright pink flowers and heart-shaped leaves that attracts bees, but also has rare red and white varieties
